

TUITION COSTS



Recreational Class Fees

*NOTE- All tuition, fees and deposits are NON-REFUNDABLE

A \$100 + HST costume fee is due per dancer/per class on February 1st.

Additional Expenses Incurred Throughout the Year:

- Each dance class your child is enrolled in will perform a separate routine in the year-end recital. A costume is required for each routine. The cost per costume is \$100 per dancer, per class.

Please note: All costume payments are non-refundable.

- Tickets for the year-end recital.
- Dance shoes, tights, attire, etc. as seen in uniform list and specific to the dance style.

Photos:

Photos will be taken during a scheduled weekend photoshoot before the year-end performance. You will have the option to purchase individual and/or group photos of your dancer.

While purchasing photos is completely optional, we kindly ask that all dancers attend Photo Day so they can be included in their class Group Photo.

Exam Classes:

We are exploring the possibility of offering Acrobatic Arts and IDA Ballet exams this season. Based on interest and eligibility, select classes and/or students may be invited early in the season to begin preparing for these exams. Participation is optional but encouraged for those eligible. Please note: Additional fees will apply, and specific attire may be required.

Methods of Payment

- Tuition is payable on the 1st of each month by **E-Transfer to ancasterdancearts@gmail.com** or Credit Card (MasterCard or Visa) or Auto-pay (additional fees apply- see below) which can be done via the Parent Portal on Dance Studio Pro.

<p>1. MONTHLY PAYMENTS: Tuition is divided into ten equal payments:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The first payment is due upon enrollment to secure your spot. The remaining nine payments will be automatically charged on the 1st of each month, from October through June Note: A non-refundable administrative fee of \$25.00 + HST per family is required at the time of registration. <p>2. PAYMENT IN FULL: Pay the full year's tuition in one lump sum at enrollment and receive a 10% discount on the total tuition (after HST).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> This option is non-refundable. If a student withdraws for any reason, a credit for the unused portion of tuition will be applied to your account for future use. Note: A non-refundable administrative fee of \$25.00 + HST per family is required at the time of registration. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> E-Transfer: Any payments coming in these forms must be received on/or before the 1st of each month to ancasterdancearts@gmail.com Auto-pay: You can choose to set up the auto-pay at the time of registration. This form of payment allows the studio to take payment at the beginning of each month. Should you choose this form of payment a 3.05% + \$0.35 convenience fee will be added Major Credit Card: We are able to take payment online with one of these methods. Please note that a 3.05% + \$0.35 convenience fee will be added to this form of payment

NOTES:

- In the event of a declined or rejected payment (e.g., due to insufficient funds, expired cards, or incorrect billing information), you will be notified via email. A replacement payment must be submitted within 5 business days to maintain enrollment. Late fees may apply.
- If your bill has not been paid by the 6th, there is a \$11.30 late fee (\$10+hst) per month.
- Tuition is charged as a flat fee for the full course and does not change based on attendance. Missed classes will not result in a refund or reduction in fees.
- Tuition is not adjusted for studio closures due to holidays or inclement weather. Make-up classes may be offered at the discretion of Ancaster Dance Arts staff, but are not guaranteed.
- Tuition is based on the total number of classes for the full season, not by the number of classes each month. Some months may have more or fewer classes, but monthly payments remain consistent.
